Goldman, Sachs suspended a plan to build a headquarters downtown in part because a proposed tunnel to be located beneath the site "would send traffic racing past the building's entrance, making it too perilous for pedestrians, and too daunting and forbidding for clients or visitors" ("Goldman Plans at Ground Zero Are in Doubt," news article, April 5).
